

This Workplace Covered by the Michigan Right To Know Law

Employers must make available for employees a readily accessible manner Safety Data Sheets (SDS) for those hazardous chemicals in the workplace.

SDS(s) For This Workplace Are Located At

Form for listing SDS locations, including fields for Location(s), Location(s), Person(s) responsible for SDS(s), and Phone.

As Required by the Michigan Right To Know Law

New or Revised SDS

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Informational Sheet: YOUTH EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS ACT 90 of 1978, as amended

The Michigan Occupational Safety and Health Act, 1974 PA 154, AS AMENDED, REQUIRES POSTING OF THIS DOCUMENT IN A CENTRAL AND CONSPICUOUS LOCATION, FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN A PENALTY.

MICHIGAN LAW PROHIBITS DISCRIMINATION

IN EMPLOYMENT, EDUCATION, HOUSING, PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION, LAW ENFORCEMENT OR PUBLIC SERVICE. BASED ON religion, race (including hair texture and protective hairstyles), color, national origin, sex, disability, marital status, gender identity or expression, age, marital status, weight, height, arrest records, genetic information, and familial status.

PAID MEDICAL LEAVE ACT

The Paid Medical Leave Act, 2018 PA 330, as amended by 2019 PA 308, effective March 20, 2019, covers employees who employ 50 or more individuals. The Act covers individuals employed in service to an employer in the business of the employer where the employee is engaged to perform a substantial function.
